INSTRUCTIONS:

- Application forms will be available February 3, 2020 on the card rack by the Conference Room or the church website: www.goodshepherdaberdeen.org
- Applications should be typewritten or computer generated. Respond to all questions. If not applicable, please indicate so.
- Information should be accurate and neatly presented.
- A copy of your latest authorized, signed transcript must accompany the application (current college students must be enrolled in at least 12 credits per semester). Applications and transcripts must be submitted to Good Shepherd Lutheran Church office *to be stamped and signed by authorized staff.*
- Applications MUST be in the church office no later than **NOON on March 16, 2020.**

INFORMATION:

- Good Shepherd post high school education scholarships are offered to students planning to attend any post secondary institution (college, vocational, technical or trade school) in the fall of 2020. This scholarship is not available for students going into Graduate studies and above.
- Applications will be available February 3, 2020 and should be returned to the church office no later than NOON on March 16, 2020. NO applications will be accepted after this time.
- Scholarships are awarded competitively based on the following criteria: grades, church involvement, community/volunteer activities, and quality of the fully completed application.
- The minimum scholarship award will be at least \$100. Not all applicants can expect to receive a scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients are determined by the Scholarship Committee, who base their decisions on the information in the application and the transcripts.

CHECKLIST before submitting application/transcript:

- Application has been typewritten or computer generated.
- Information is accurate and neatly presented.
- Responded to all questions. If not applicable, have indicated so.
- **The latest authorized, signed transcript must accompany the application form and returned to Good Shepherd Lutheran Church office to be stamped by authorized staff. Deadline: NOON March 16, 2020.** (Current college students must be enrolled in at least 12 credits per semester.)
